Clos de Ste Anne is a single vineyard situated on steep northeast facing slopes in the foothills of Poverty Bay. The 2005 Pinot Noir comes from older plantings off the original Naboth's Vineyard 1 Kings Ch. 21 as well as a new collection of modern clones from a planting further along the slope in a section we call "La Cote" Hand harvested fruit was chilled over night, sorted and fermented with native yeasts in individual wooden cuves for a total of 28 days. Aged in special Burgundian barrels for 12 months, bottled using the finesty natural cork and aged before release. Subtle fruit characters with complex secondary flavours and finely grained tannins will allow this wine to develop its true personality over time. Bottled without filtration.

Cellaring potential five years from the date of release.
